- Academic records
- Passport size photo
- Resume, including any existing qualifications
- Experience outline for mature students or working adults

2 Create an essay or video with the subject matter for the submission as:

**'What interests you about a career in the hospitality and tourism industry?'**

The requirements for this is either:

- Essay - word limit 500 +/- 10%
- Video - 2 mins maximum in length
