# REGIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

## **OVERVIEW**

The Regional Student Scholarship aims to provide financial assistance to individuals residing in non-urban areas within Australia, pursuing the Bachelor or Business in Hotel Management at The Hotel School city locations. These scholarships address the unique challenges faced by rural and remote students, supporting the financial impact to access higher education in city locations, easing the burden of relocation. These scholarships promote diversity in academia, fostering talent and leadership in regional regions, ensuring equal educational opportunities for all.

Scholarship amounts vary depending on each application to a maximum of \$10,000.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Australian citizens or permanent residents.
- Residing outside of Major Cities of Australia deemed as rural or regional areas within Australia.\*
- Applied to the Bachelor of Business in Hotel Management at one of The Hotel School city campuses.

# **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Applicants must have applied and been admitted to the course prior to submitting a Scholarship Application.

- 1. Create a 500 word response or 2-minute video addressing the questions below:
  - a. What are you hoping to gain during your studies at The Hotel School?
  - b. How will this scholarship support you to in beginning your studies at The Hotel School?
- 2. Submit your response along with supporting documentation of your home address within a rural or remote area within Australia to <a href="mailto:thssscholarships@scu.edu.au">thssscholarships@scu.edu.au</a>
- 3. Successful applicants will then be invited to a 30 minute interview with the Head of Campus. This can be completed online or in person on campus.

- Students must have applied to the Bachelor of Business in Hotel Management at one of The Hotel School city campuses prior to submitting a scholarship application.
- The scholarship value will be split into four instalments. These amounts will be credited to your Southern Cross University student account after census date of each Term, following your second Term of study.
- The scholarship is not transferable or deferable.
- As a scholarship recipient you will be required to attend and participate in various online and offline activities
  as our ambassador such as; webinars, promotional films, interviews for marketing campaigns, student
  generated digital content for social media, open campus, promotional days and careers markets. We will also
  value your participation as a mentor to other students.
- To maintain your scholarship, you must maintain continuous study and achieve at least a pass grade in each unit in which you are enrolled.
